






Mathew 28:5-7

HUMBLE ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate and Graduate students who are members of Pratt First United Methodist Church may apply for the Humble Endowment Scholarship at <u>prattume.org</u>. Go to Youth, Scholarships and Humble Endowment Scholarship. Follow all the guidelines listed. The application and letters of reference must be received by the last Monday in April to be considered. In 2021 the date is April 26. All required information must be submitted electronically (including references) to <u>umcpratt @ prattume.org</u>.

Each year two Humble Scholarships of \$1,500 per semester will be awarded. The applicant must have a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale. Past and present involvement in the church will be a major consideration as well as involvement the community. Music majors are given a preference over other majors.

The scholarship is applied for on a yearly basis. The same person could receive the scholarship more than one year in a row but must reapply each year.

Our 10:00 a.m. Worship Service is recorded and uploaded to the church's Facebook page,


