



PRATT FUMC SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS FOR SPRING SEMESTER

Attention: High School Graduates & College Students

Applications for Pratt FUMC scholarship awards for the Spring Semester 2020 are available and must be submitted online at www.prattumc.org.

- 1. Look under the "Youth" tab and click on "Scholarship."
- 2. You will need to click two places: one for Scholarship Application Instructions and one to fill out the actual scholarship application on-line.

If you are a member of the Pratt First United Methodist Church, you are eligible to apply. Please follow the application directions carefully, complete the application on-line and submit requested materials to the church office by **January 14, 2020**. The Scholarship Committee awarded \$1000 to each student who qualified for the scholarship this past semester. The Committee will meet to review the completed applications in January and inform the applicants whether or not they have been granted a scholarship.


