

FUMC reopened sanctuary May 24; in person worship now available

Beginning Sunday, May 24th, First United Methodist Church of Pratt reopened our sanctuary so in person worship is now available. We will continue to have one worship service at 10:00 a.m. throughout the month of June. We will no longer have worship on Facebook Live. Instead, we will record our worship service and upload it to the church's Facebook page as soon as possible following the service.

Sunday morning worship will certainly not immediately return to "normal." There are many guidelines to follow. First, we want to emphasize that those who are at risk to Covid19 because of age or health issues, please remain at home and watch the recorded service. We cannot emphasize this enough: THOSE WHO ARE AT RISK TO COVID 19 BECAUSE OF AGE OR HEALTH ISSUES, PLEASE REMAIN AT HOME AND WATCH THE RECORDED SERVICE.

For those who choose to attend worship in person, the only entrance and exit for the building will be the narthex doors on the south end of the sanctuary. We will maintain social distancing, which means there will be marked places to sit in the pews, at six foot intervals. Couples and families who reside in the same house may sit together, all others please observe the marked seating. When entering and exiting, please observe social distancing to the best of your ability.

Please, no hand shaking or hugging, as hard as that is! For the time being, no nursery will be available. We will not have Sunday School or a time of fellowship before or after the service, so please remain in the sanctuary or the narthex, using only the restrooms in the narthex. There will be hand sanitizer at the doors. The use of a mask is your choice. Ushers will be on hand to assist with maintaining social distancing.

We will not pass attendance pads or offering plates. There will be designated places set up for you to place your offering. You may also continue to use the online giving tab at www.prattumc.org, mail your offering to PO Box 316, or drop your offering off at the office during the week.

We understand that some are ready to return to in-person worship and some are not. We respect both choices and will continue to strive to provide meaningful worship for all.


Ladies Bible Study Groups Resume Meeting


